

# **Children's Worker**

## **Job Description:**

We are looking for individuals who love to work with school-aged children and understand the urgency of sharing Christ with refugee children, many of whom have never heard about Jesus before. An awareness of the children's traumatic experiences and unstable life situation as refugees is essential, as these are often reflected in their behaviour. There needs to be both a willingness to learn culturally appropriate ways of communicating the Gospel, and flexibility, as our context often brings surprises.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Setting up the Kids' Room
- Preparing lessons, illustrations, crafts, games and other activities
- Creating a safe, affirming, fun environment where children can experience the love of Christ - Working together with the native-speaker believer who will do the Bible teaching - Creating a sense of community among the children present
- Supervising, keeping order and negotiating disputes in a loving manner
- Interacting with the children as they colour, paint, work on a craft, or play games - Including local volunteers, interns and short-term team members into the day's program by suggesting ways they can be helpful
- Putting things away and cleaning up the room after the day's program has ended - Participating in team meetings, activities, retreats, prayer days, and any other role expected of team members

## **Essential Experience and skills:**

- Experience and training in working with children

## **Desired Experience:**

- Cross cultural mission work, whether short or long term
- Farsi/Dari language knowledge or a willingness to learn

**Salary:** This role requires 100% fund raising
